Egg Donor Program

Egg donor

- Oocytes donated by women between the ages of 21 and below 38 at the point of oocyte removal.
- Performed in Singapore
- Nurse shall assess the potential donor's intend, ensure the potential donor meet the age criteria,
- Explain the process of the oocyte donor and fill up a lifestyle questionnaire (Live Donor Assessment Questionnaire).
- Refer potential donor for psychosocial assessment. It must be done together with the spouse if the potential donor is married.
- The Psychiatrist/ Psychologist shall assess the potential donor on suitability to donate.
- When psychological reply has endorsed by The Clinical Governance Officer, IVF counselling (which involved the oocyte stimulation and the oocyte retrieval process) is given to potential donor and spouse if married.

What does it involve?

- Blood investigations for Full Blood Count, Hepatitis B, Hepatitis C, VDRL, HIV, CMV blood IgG, IgM, HTLV Type I and II, urine Gonorrhoea, Chlamydia and CMV isolation, blood group and Rh will be taken
- Antral Follicle Count and Day2 FSH/LH/E2 will be arranged.
- Potential donor is given <u>at least 7 days</u> for donor to consider before signing consent
- Nurse shall arrange an appointment with Doctor for donor consent taking, and the doctor shall fill up the donor's details direct into the IVF database system.
- The doctor shall perform the physical assessment and clinical examination.

- Nurse shall arranged another TCU with Doctor for the potential donor to see the doctor for IVF consent taking and treatment regime as plan.
- The nurse coordinator shall organize to start the donor with the oocyte stimulation and oocyte retrieval.
- The nurse shall arrange for a repeat blood screening 3 months after the oocyte retrieval.
