



Early Intervention Programme for Infants and Children **(EIPIC)**

What is EIPIC?

Under SG Enable, the Early Intervention Programme for Infants and Children (EIPIC) provides intervention support for children with developmental needs.

Each child's developmental needs will be assessed by the EIPIC team who will develop an individualised programme to maximize each child's developmental potential.

Working together with parents, EIPIC aims to optimise the motor, language, social-emotional, learning, and behavioural skills of each child.

EIPIC is not a school and does not replace preschool or childcare. Your child can attend both concurrently.

Generally, the duration of each EIPIC session ranges from 2 to 4 hours and the frequency ranges from 2 to 5 days per week, depending on the assessment of your child's needs.

How do I register my child for EIPIC?

The Medical Social Worker will assist you with the application.

Where are the EIPIC centres and how much does it cost?

There are many centres around the island. Some offer transport services. You can refer to the website below for further details.
