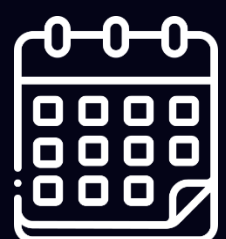


# Gastrointestinal Pathology Course 2023
