

# Local Anaesthesia Techniques for Foot and Ankle 9 & 16 January 2025

#### Introduction

This course will allow participants to learn different injection techniques (e.g. ring block, skin infiltration) for local anesthetic in the context of podiatric practice.

#### **Course Objectives**

At the end of the course, participants will be able to:

- Critically evaluate the indications/contraindications for local anaesthetic injection therapy in the lower limb.
- Critically appraise the pharmacological principles surrounding the safe use of local anaesthetics for injection.
- Demonstrate advanced anatomical knowledge associated with local anaesthetic injection administration.
- Learn different techniques (eg. ring block, skin infiltration) for different procedure (nail surgery, wound debridement, wart treatment).
- 5) Effectively communicate with patients & colleagues the role of local anaesthetic injection therapy.
- 6) Clearly identify appropriate pre and post injection care
- 7) Safely carry out the pre-requisite number of injections, including appropriate aseptic technique.
